CHILDCARE PROVISION DURING SCHOOL CLOSURE DUE TO CORONAVIRUS

Due to the small number of pupils attending schools across our area, we have decided to create a 'hub' school at Leyburn Primary School during this crisis, starting from Monday 30th March until further notice.

Each day, there will be at least a member of teaching staff and a senior leader. We will also ensure there is paediatric first aid cover and a designated leader for child protection on site at all times.

Contact details for the hub school are 01969 623187. You will need to drop your children off at the front door where they will be collected and this is where you can collect them at the end of the day.

If you are entitled to a school meal as your child is in EYFS/Year 1/2, we are in the process of sorting logistics out. In the meantime, we would appreciate if you could provide your child with a packed lunch (no nuts please).

For weekly forward planning for staffing, we must know your childcare requirements for the following week by Thursday. You can email this information to leyburn@ycatschools.co.uk or let the hub know in person.

Do not put your child/family/household/ our staff at further risk by using this facility unless absolutely necessary. Children are safer at home in a situation where their social interaction/contact is limited.

Families must complete this registration document before their child can start. If medical needs change during the coronavirus outbreak, please let the hub know.

Provision

- I understand that the provision is childcare and not 'school'.
- I appreciate that should it become impossible for School to staff the provision due to staff illness or self-isolation, then the childcare will cease with immediate effect and that this may be with very little notice. We will ensure that you are directed to alternative provision as agreed with the Local Authority.
- My child will enter the school through the main office door once they have been signed in.
- I understand that no parent/carer will be allowed beyond the office door into the building (unless in a medical emergency).

Health risks

- I understand that the school and parents/carers need to undertake as stringent practice as possible to reduce the risks of transmission of the virus (and other illnesses).
- I understand that the school is a childcare school where my child will play with other children. The school is therefore unable to limit my child's social contact with other children.
- I understand that the adults working in the school will try to maintain common sense in terms of social distancing whilst working with the children; however, they are caring for the children and therefore may work closer than 2 metres with them.
- I understand that whilst the school will endeavour to regularly clean the areas used and will engage in frequent hand washing, we are unable to guarantee a virus-free school.
- I will ensure that my child has high levels of hygiene and cleanliness to reduce risk of



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transmission.

Clothing/personal items

- I will endeavour to ensure that my child is wearing school uniform. They should bring a coat and a PE kit.
- Where practicable, my child will wear clean clothes each day (to reduce the risk of transmission).
- My child will not bring any items to the school from home with them except necessary medication (handed to member of staff on arrival) and their packed lunch.

Medication/illness

- I will not bring my child to the school if they have any symptoms of coronavirus or if anyone in the household has symptoms. I will isolate my child and the whole household for 14 days if this is the case and will inform the school immediately by email –**
- If my child has medication for asthma, allergies or other conditions, I will ensure that they have the medication with them every day in a labelled container. I understand that this medication will come home every day (in case the school has to close without notice). It is my responsibility to ensure that the medication is in date.
- I understand that if my child needs any other form of medication, I will need to complete a 'Medication Form' (available from the school office). Administration of medication will need to be agreed by the Headteacher / senior leader on duty.
- I will inform the member of staff on arrival if I have given my child any medication e.g. Calpol, before they come to the school.
- I understand that if my child becomes unwell during their time in the school, they will be immediately placed in isolation (in accordance with government guidance) and I will be contacted and asked to collect them as soon as possible. If I can't be reached, the other contacts given will be called. I understand that the school staff will not have to prove or justify their decision about a child's illness.
- I understand that if my child falls dangerously ill the staff will contact medical services as well as contacting me.
